EVOLVING THE SOLUTION

- ✓ Redesigned Early Education Services for pre-K children and after school daycare offer improved features and aesthetics.
- Revised grading plan for improved sight lines and reduced building visibility.
- ✓ Redesigned waste water treatment facility and associated water recycling infrastructure will reduce use of potable water on the site.
- ✓ Modified storm water system to ensure excess storm water is captured and disposed of properly to minimize impact to adjacent watersheds.
- Relocated maintenance barn and community garden to make better use of topography.
- ✓ Refined second driveway on Coolidge Drive to align with safe pedestrian and traffic engineering principles.
