- ✓ Reduced height of several buildings, including two buildings on the western edge to seven stories.
- ✓ Increased building density to maintain total bed count.
- ✓ Expanded lower cost options with more shared rooms.
- ✓ Improved visual appeal through architectural revisions.
- ✓ Redesigned graduate student housing for more building connectivity and community.
- ✓ Increased variety in unit design.
- ✓ Widened northern loop road.
- ✓ Modified storm water control system.
